- **Park at the Library:** After you cross Whiskey Creek and enter Churchville, keep your eyes out for volunteers on your left with fluorescent yellow safety vests on. They will guide you in to park and answer questions. The library is generously allowing

visitors to use the restrooms. Portable toilets and a handwashing station will be available at the main festival site.

- **Bring Raingear**: The festival is rain or shine. Mushrooms love rain and so do mushroom hunters.
- **Bring A Water Bottle**: We want to avoid plastic water bottle waste and May Supply of Harrisonburg will be generously providing a drinking water station for the festival. Stainless festival cups will be available for purchase.
- **Family Friendly**: We sincerely want everyone to enjoy themselves. There will be free face painting and activities for children and affordable treats. Please use respectful language (avoid profanity), keep the focus on fun (no political discussions), and please choose attire that is appropriate. Thank you for helping us create a welcoming respectful space where families feel comfortable.
